FUND OBJECTIVE

The fund's investment objective is to achieve both capital growth and income. The fund will invest primarily in UK gilts. The fund may also invest in other fixed interest securities.

INVESTMENT APPROACH

The portfolio manager draws upon the output of our credit analysts and quantitative analysts in constructing the portfolio. The primary drivers of return are asset allocation, yield curve positioning, interest rate expectations, sector allocation and security valuation. We therefore look to build bond portfolios that include a large number of uncorrelated active investment decisions in which no single position is expected to dominate returns.
